My father says Mr. Wagner will tel about this better than he can. I meant to ask whether Sitting Bull had his horse staked out beside his tent, Did he? No

Or did he have to go and catch a horse? Yes

Or did he have a horse in that fight with Reno and Custer? Yes What horse did he ride? Black horse.

Was Gall a chief? What kind of chief? When was he made a chief? Gall was never a chief, but a man of good understanding and tries to do what is right.

What men were Sitting Bull's strongest friends in those days just before the battle on the Little Big Horn? Was Inkpaduta a good friend to Sitting Bull? Yes

And others he couldn't remember their names Whick policemankilled Crowfoot? Done Bear, died two years ago. Did he have any trouble with Sitting Bull before this? Policeman killed Crowfoot. Crowfoot was only 17 years old and had no previous trouble with Lone Man nor any trouble with Sitting Bull Did Red Tomahawk ever have any personal quarrel with Sitting Bull or any of his men before the arrest and death of Sitting Bull.
