*Nail Bear*

The tribes herein mentioned all retreated back to where the Soldiers were. Those who took part were as follows; Old Bull, One Bull, Appearing Bear, White Hand Bear, Bobtail Bull, Swift Bear, Gray Bull, Elk Nation, Chasing Eagle, Red Bird, White Swan, Red Fox, Bear Soldier, Black Bear, Flying By, Pretends Eagle, Bear Shield, Little Moon. The above are all living. They belonged to the Hunkpapa clan. This battle was fought after the sun-dance and before the Custer battle. Often-kills-enemy, Ears, White Crane Walking, Iron Star, Lone Man, Breaks-up, Strikes-the-kettle, Sitting white Bull and Good Crow. These men were wounded. The following men were very brave in battle; Black Crow, Good Bear, Male Crow, Charging Hawk, Shoots Enemy, Red Feather, Long Dog, Iron Thunder, Crazy Horse, Black Fox, ~~Runs-without-fear~~, Against Cloud, Spotted Elk, Iron Magpie, Charges, Little Elk, Bullhead, High Horse, Fighting Bear, Looking Horse, Little Bear, Crawler, (Crawler or Slohan or Hunka-yapi was camp crier for the Fox Lodge)(fz) ~~Fishes in Kettle~~, Little Wound, Feather-in-hair, Magpie Eagle, Has Horns, Young Bear, One Elk, Two Moon, Sitting Bear, Intestines, Big Head, Black Bear, Red Bird, Bone Club, Rain-in-the-face, Gall, Bear-scares-away, Red Dog, Loves War, and Gray Eagle.

Sitting Bull went west beyond the Little Bighorn mountains and brought back a buckskin horse. The tribe he took this horse from, lived in straw or grass tents. Another big battle took place near the mouth of some river which empties into the Yellow Stone, between the Sioux and the Crows. The Crows left their tipi's and fled west. The Sioux were victorious. The different clans who fought the Crows were, Hunkpapa, Itazipco, Minneconoju, Ogallala, Cheyennes. These bands also fought two bands of Utes. Prominent men in this fight are as follows; Old Bull, Myself, Sitting Bull, Jumping Buffalo, Iron Bull, Sitting Crow, Middle Bull, Little Buffalo, Fool Heart, Holy Eagle, Swift Bird, They Charge on Him, (literal translation) Little Horse, Bears Charge on him, ( " " ) Running Horse, Crazy Buffalo, The Elk whose-voice-can-be-heard-while-walking, (literal translation) Gray Eagle, Eagle Bear, Swift Bear, Catch-the-bear, Redthunder, Sitting White Cow and Brave Crow.
