S.B.'s father was sometimes called Jumping Badger. Believe his real name was Jumping Buffalo. His wife was Her Holy Door. Children were: Wiyaka wastewin (Pretty Feather); Tatonka Iyotanke (Sitting Bull); *1834-90* Cekpa win (Twin Woman.) Pretty Feather died in 1885; Sitting Bull in 1890; Twin Woman in 1876.

Sitting Bull adopted an Assiniboine and named him Jumping Buffalo after his own father. This man was killed at the arrest of Sitting Bull, Dec 15, 1890. The translation of Assiniboine is Hehe. ) *AB*
