Dear Sir,

Answering yours of July 21 concerning Sitting Bull, I know nothing of the man personally. The chief skirmish we had on that trip (1866) was in vicinity of the Custer battle field. Being a Civil War veteran and having had three years of fighting during that war I did not think much of the Indian tactics at that time. We lost one man and how many of <sup>the Indians</sup> those were put out I do not know. Neither do I know whether Sitting Bull was in command or not as it was ten years before the Custer massacre, *and he was not so famous at that time*

The account of this trip has been published several times but I have no copy at present nor do I know where I can find one.
