I am anxious to give a full account of Sitting Bull's life as prisoner of war. Also I should be happy to have a copy of your photograph of Sitting Bull taken by Goff. Of course I should expect to pay for having the print made, if you care to have one made for me. As I expected, I am being severely criticized in some quarters for representing Sitting Bull as a warrior and a chief.
