

Dear Professor Campbell:

When I last wrote you I neglected to mention one item in the collections of this Society which might be of considerable interest to you. The item in question is a tabulation of 41 Indian engagements in Wyoming, Montana, Idaho, Nebraska, Texas and South Dakota in the period from 1854 to 1890. It was compiled by General William C. Brown from notes taken by Walter M. Camp, who visited all the battle sites. The tabulation as we have it is in the form of a large blue print. The notes on which it is based are, I believe, in the possession of Mr. Camp's widow, who resides at 7740 South Union Avenue, Chicago. Our last information about the notes is dated 1930. The 1932 Chicago directory lists a Walter M. Camp, probably a son, at the Chicago address mentioned.

Very likely you know General Brown and it may be that he has sent you a copy of this tabulation. On the chance that you have not been in touch with the General, I will say that his address is 875 Marion Street, Denver, Colorado.
