My dear Prof. Campbell:

On November 30th, Mr. Higheagle, a Sioux Indian, appealed to us for temporary relief stating that he was stranded and was enroute from Ft. Yates, North Dakota to Oklahoma City and that he was doing some research work for the University at Norman. He has been writing a biography of "Sitting Bull". He also stated he had lived in Pine Ridge and Ft. Yates and several other Dakota towns and had been a teacher in the Government Schools.

Mr. Higheagle told us that he sent a telegram to you asking for a loan of \$10.00. He was told to come to our office on Monday morning and let us know regarding further plans. A grocery order was given at this time but he failed to show up on Monday.

Is Mr. Higheagle known to you? If so are his statements true in regard to the research work and writing of a life history of "Sitting Bull"? His story was rather interesting and we are anxious to check up on his statements. Has he arrived in Oklahoma City to your knowledge?

We will appreciate hearing from you.
