1. Pine Ridge Battle field '89 to 1890 - 1909
2. Wounded Knee with Red Clouds tipi - 1909
3. Grass Creek - where St. Kelly was killed -
4. Croco Butte, Neb. where the Cheyennes fought a battle up in the canyon of the Butte, on their return escape from Ft. Sill 1878 & where Bull Knife and the old & young were rounded up & taken to Ft. Robinson, the rest, under Little Wolf - got away. (2 paintings)
5. - Fort Yates with Sitting Bull's grave, during a fierce dust storm 1938 painted from the hotel meadow
- 6 - Elbow woods agency, where Lewis & Clark wintered nearby
7. - Mouth of Little Missouri -
- 8 - Genl Anthony Wagners first camp on march to "Fallen Timbers" from Ft. Washington Cinc. O. at Mt. Healthy, O.
- 9 - Custer Battle field, and Crow Camp site.
- 10 - Reno's Crossing,
- 11 - Scaffold grave on Reno Hill (1910) the only real scaffold grave I ever saw, now gone
- 12 - Custer's last campsite - at Busby Mont, on his march -
- 13 - Rosebud Canyon - fight took place between Crook & Crazy Horse June 17 - 1876
- 14 - Line of Custers last days march - pointed out by "Goeshead" scout.
- 15 - Chief Joseph's Battle field & Surrender - 1877 - Snake Creek, near Chinook Mont.
- 16 - Big Hole Battle field - Mont.
- 17 - Father De Smet's mission, St Ignatius, Mont. built 1860 - the old one
- 18 - Flathead Lake & Pablos last head of Buffalo Range in the U. S.
- 19 - Blackfeet Camp -
- 20 - Mission at Browning Mont.
- 21 - Blackfoot Camp (large) with mountains in distance -
- 22 - Mouth of Grand Coulee, Columbia River, at Kespelem Wash.
- 23 - Entrance to Fort Phil Kearny, Wyo, (restored)
- 24 - Site of famous Wagon Box fight, Story, Wyo.
- 25 - Genl Fremont's Pass - Wind river Res. Wyo.
- 26 - Burial ground & Sacajawae's grave - same place
- 27 - Mandan dirt lodges on Missouri river, overlooking ~~the river~~ ^{the river}
