

I have your letter of November 22nd from France. I am looking for that untranscribed column of November 23d, 1851, from the Missouri Republican in regard to the Fort Laramie Treaty of 1851. Of course this treaty was not at Fort Laramie, but "a considerable several" miles east and not in Wyoming but in Nebraska where Horse Creek, which has its rise in Wyoming, empties into the North Platte. I shall make a search again for this information, which in a hurried examination I could not find, because all of this is sort of past history and has been filed away. I shall be very glad to do it and it affords me great pleasure.
