Brininstool, Box 1072, Station C, Los Angeles, California. It will perhaps cost you something to use these maps, but if he has them it will be very worth while.

As to maps in my "Bozeman Trail" published by The Arthur H. Clark Company, Glendale, California, these maps were drawn with the assistance of men who were in the Fort Phil Kearny fight of August 2, 1867, and the Hay Field Fight of August 1 of the same year. These maps are strongly copyrighted and no use could be made of them without the permission of my publisher as above indicated. I am making this accurate statement to you because the Movie Magazine a number of years ago copied my map and used it without permission and my publisher brought heavy suit against the magazine which he won.

I am interested that you are continuing in your work of the battles of Wyoming and surrounding states. Surely Montana and Wyoming with the Dakotas had their share of Indian difficulties. If I can aid you any further than I am aiding you, I shall be very glad to help you.
