In addition to what can be found in books, the Commissioner of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Ottawa - would be the best source of information - as all the Police reports since 1875 (the first printed) are under his care. Colonel James Walker, Calgary, Alberta came with the Mounted Police to the West (Fort Hoped) in 1874. He is about the only survivor of that famous march, 900 miles westward from the Red River.
