On the back of each one is what the Army officer understood Sitting Bull to say was the story, but there are some mistakes in this, I find. I want the true story.

All these pictures were made before 1870, probably by Little Assiniboine (Hohe) the boy Sitting Bull adopted. Sitting Bull said they were copies of some he gave to this boy.

I wish you would try to find out about these drawings, and write down on the back of each one just what the true story is. Or write out the true story on another piece of paper, and number it the same as the drawing. Every drawing has a number.

I have just got back from a business trip, and find it will be a few days before I can send you the money. However, it will not be long. I want you to go right ahead and get this data, and I will pay you as before. Now is the time to do this work, before winter sets in.
