Under separate cover I am sending you the reproduction of Sitting Bull's medicine cloth. I am sorry that you had to wait so long for it. It is an exact copy. The little thong tied to one corner is taken from the original. Even the rents and stains are true. In only one respect may there be detected any difference- the color of the cloth in the original is a little faded.

I am also sending you exact measurements of the other objects in the bundle- the deer tail, the buffalo fur wristlets, and the calamus root.

I trust that you will be satisfied with this copy, even though it is not possible to supply you with the buffalo fur and deer tail.

I have recently had letters from a Mr. Balmer, of Zurich- 9 Altstetten. Perhaps you know him.
