News Bullhead said SB was preparing to flee

Plan was to arrest SB, put him in lute wagon,
rush to Oak Creek & turn over to Fechet -

F + 6 troops & Car - detachment of artillery, one

Gath's gun, one Hotchkiss breechloading rifle

Bush out to Oak Creek at 4:30 a.m.

Pushed beyond, not find a scout,
- gray dawn met a policeman, who said
entire Co. of native troops had been killed -

Pushed forward - found Indo firing into
SB's house, where (scout) said police had
taken refuge - a Hotchkiss shell, then disintd
troops charged & cleared woods -

Saw 8 dead by SB house, SB big one -
4 dead police in house & 3 wounded,

2 mortally -) police entered house at 5:50 a.m.

SB arrested

He took his time dressing + took it quietly -
his son Crowfoot reproached him -
for submitting - SB obstinate + refused to go

After some parley, the police took him out +
found themselves surrounded - Police pushed
back crowd, + SB kept calling for rescue -
McLaughlin says

He said that if the 2 principal men were to -
(Bullhead + Sharkhead) he not would run away -
& finally called out to them to begin the fight -

whereupon Catch - Bear + Striker - the Kettle, 2
of SB's men, dashed thru crowd + fired -

C - B shot Bullhead right side + he instantly
wheeled + shot SB in left side between 10 + 11 ribs

8 - K's shot having passed thru Shark
Head's abdomen, all 3 fell together -

Prof. Wm. Mann at once shot Catch & Bear,

Fite became general, & police got into house
