In some cases, as in that of the Osages, Kaws, Poncas, Otoes, Pawnees and some other smaller tribes, almost every available child of suitable age is now in school, and within a comparatively short period there will be in these tribes a new generation of/ English-speaking people with scarcely a vestige of the Indian tongue or Indian customs remaining. But in many other instances, notably among the Navajos, Pimas, Apaches, and others, the great mass of the children are as yet unprovided with any proper school facilities and are growing up in ignorance, superstition and barbarism, making little progress and with little hope of improvement. What has already been accomplished for other tribes should be done for these.
