yours of the 14th came to hand in due time
and as miss Grace Raymond Hebard
is a dear friend of mine - I showed her your letter
& have all ready given her some of the Hapendens
of the old days of wyo + as she also writing
a Book + of the old days of wyo + and she told
me + to write to you + and tell you all I knew
of the Indians - Getting Bull - but in the first
place + you will have to pardon me for poor
writing & Spelling + as I had no chance of getting
any good ~~settling~~ schooling + there was not a school
nearer than Ogden City Utah + about 150 miles
from the town where I was brought up + Fort Bridger
wyo + I came to wyo + in 1857 + at the age of 7 years
I have been in three wars myself + as the Indians
were on the war path nearly all the time + and the
country sparsely settled + I am the oldest timer
in the state of Wyoming + to say + here is a few living
wyo that came in on the Rail Road + when it arrived
here + in wyo + in 1867 + Laramie 10th of may + 1868
Bull + I knew him - and I know a Bout settling
I been selected + by Indian Agents + of three different
Reservations - as Boss Farmer + for the Indians + at different
times + and have been among them nearly all my
life + consequently I have acquired a good deal of
their language + in the 60-70-80 - the Indians would
make trips to visit their friends + as some of
them are friendly with one another + and some are
fighting among them selves + getting Bull used to
come to the Pieles Reservation on a visit - at the time I
was working for the U.S. Government + over
