nearer than Ogden City Utah & about 150 miles
wyo & I came to wyo in 1857 - at the age of 7 years
I have been in three wars myself - as the Indians
were on the war path nearly all the time & and the
Country sparsely settled - I am the Oldest timer
in the State of Wyoming - to day - Here is a few living
there - in wyo & in 1867 - Laramie 10th of May - 1868
Bull & I knew him - and I know a Boat setting
I been selected - By Indian Agents - of three different
Reservations - as Boss Farmer - for the Indians - at different
times - and have been among them nearly all my
life, consequently I have acquired a good deal of
their language - in the 60.70 80 - the Indians would
make trips to visit their friends - as some of
them are friendly with one another - and some are
fighting among them selves & Getting Bull used to
come to the Piute Reservation on a visit - at the time - I
was working for the M. & P. Government / over
