The Battle of Killder Mountain, July 26?, 1864. General Alfred H. Sully attacks the Sloux in Dakota Territory.

Baker's Fight. Major E. M. Baker, 2nd Gavalry, repulses hostile Sioux on the Yellowstone, near mouth of Pryor's Creek, August 14, 1872.

The Hayfield Fight, near Fort C. F. Smith, August 1, 1867.

The Wagon Box Fight, near Fort Phil Kearny, August 2, 1867.

Col. J. J. Reynolds attack on the Indian village (called Crazy Horse's village) on Powder river, March 17, 1876.

The Battle of the Rosebud; General Geo. Crook engages hostile Indiana, June 17, 1876, on the Rosebud in Montana.
