I am seeking photographs pertaining to the Indian battles listed below. I am interested in photographs of the sites and participants; also in maps of these battlefields. Mr. J. G. Masters, of Omaha, has suggested that you might be able to assist me. If you have any photographs of the sort I should be happy to hear from you.

These are the engagements:

- ✓ (1) The Battle of Killdeer Mountain, July 26th, 1864. General Alfred H. Sully attacks the Sioux in Dakota Territory.
- ✓ (2) Baker's Fight. Major E. M. Baker, 2nd Cavalry, repulses hostile Sioux on the Yellowstone, near mouth of Pryor's Creek, August 14, 1872.
- ✓ (3) The Hayfield Fight, near Fort C. F. Smith, August 1, 1867.
- (4) The wagon box fight, near Fort Phil Kearny, August 2, 1867.
- ✓ (5) Col. J. J. Reynolds attack on the Indian village (called Crazy Horse's village) on Powder River, March 17, 1876.
- ✓ (6) The Battle of the Rosebud; General Geo. Crook engages hostile Indians, June 17, 1876, on the Rosebud in Montana.
- (7) Slim Buttes, South Dakota, September 9, 1876.
