For Battle of the Rosebud see p 403 of Gen Anson Mills "My Story" privately printed but I think I saw an Extra Copy on sale at W.
H. Lowdermilks store on F St NW 14th and 15th Sts Washington. As
there is printing on 4 404 I cant copy it It could however be
copied by photostat.

I have never seen any sketch of Reynolds fight Mch 17, 1876 but the routes taken by troops in that short Campaign Mch 1-26 is shown on the map "Stanton Map" made by Capt W. S. Stanton U S Engrs and Chas Morton Adjt 3d of the Expedition. This map is in Engr Div. office of Chief of Engrs U S A - File No. A. G. O.
