

There are a number of publishers who specialize in western stuff such as: Milton, Balch and Co., New York; also the Stokes Company, New York. The only way to reach them is to send out your material, which should be typewritten, to each publisher in turn to see if he likes it. However, you can offer your work to some literary agent in New York who will handle the manuscript for you on a commission basis provided he thinks he can sell it. Do not have anything to do with an agent who demands payment from you before he sells the manuscript. The best literary agent in New York, I believe, is Brandt and Brandt, 101 Park Avenue, New York City. Do not be discouraged if your material is not accepted right away. The first hundred rejections are the hardest. If your material is humorous it will probably have a better chance.
