I have your letter of October 13. I hope you will enjoy the book. Thanks for your information. One question I would like to ask. Is Kicking Bear the same man as Catch the Bear? Please let me hear everything you can find out about Sitting Bull.

I have asked the Supt. of Buildings and Grounds about carpenter work in Oklahoma this winter. He says he thinks there will be a good deal of work in Oklahoma City and here all winter. This town is twenty miles from Oklahoma City. They pay good carpenters six to eight dollars a day down here he says. In this town the carpenters have to belong to the Union but non-union men can get work in Oklahoma City. He says he thinks you will find more work here than in Dakota this winter. I do not know whether he himself will have any work for you or not but he is sure Mr. Waggoner can find something to do.
