

northwest until they reached Chalky Buttes on the headwaters of Sand Creek, North Dakota, and wintered there. They returned to Sitting Bull's camp on Tongue River in the spring. The following year the hostiles returned to Fort Pierre and stole all of Mr. Primeaux's horses, in revenge for the loss of their furs. In 1910 he was paid \$3600.00 for these horses, by the government.
