

other's feelings over the wrongs of the red men. I am happy to say that the above suggestion is no longer an experiment, but has been tried **thoroughly**, with results which are so astonishingly successful that they should be seen to be appreciated. There is a corps of Apache scouts at San Carlos, and they are doing very well, but need experienced men to deal with them. I would not recommend that they be brought under this régime at present. They live in a very difficult country, and are yet wild, having had very little con-⁴⁶⁹ / tact with white people, and having been lately at war with the United States troops. Their present management is the best one for a considerable period in the future."
