You may be able to get some information about Sitting Bull and the other old Sioux Indians from the Sioux Indian Agency at Pine Ridge, S. D. ~~Mr. J. B. Thoburn~~ of the State Historical Society at Oklahoma City is also well posted along these lines and might be able to give you some information. I shall refer you, in this connection, to Major Gordon Lillie (Pawnee Bill) who was the partner of Buffalo Bill for several years. As you no doubt know, Major Lillie lives at Pawnee, Oklahoma.
