further fact, geveral atterapts wexe made by aifterent osisears of the police poree had atteapted to break up the camp in a peaceable way, but failed.

Dusing the month of August, when the ghost dance was in tull blast, I becarne cury ous to kiow, the trust of thi f thing that has aet my ople "crazy." I in comyany with my brother, Thite Horse, msde a apecial trin themess the performance.

Having spent nearly all day, during which I had a dhane to have a personal interview with the Chief and hiving aetisfied myself of his deepest and sincereat interest with the ghost dance and as I bive alwaya been on the best of temme ith him end did not care to embarmas him in any way, I mefrained from montioning or asking any questions ab ut the matter. I ceaided then and tiocre, thit if this thing was aliosed to continue, scrae serious troubie would eventuaily be the outcone of it.

The order being tor us to act about daybreak and as the night were rathex long, wo tried to pass the intervonting time in tolling war stoxies. The Indian poliae Who were on this campaign were a oleas of Dakotas who had enviable schievements and attainments and who on account of having higheat ootimation in the minds af govemment officials,miasionaties, tradexs, as well as poeseaning good influence in their respective communities.

Dayoreak was drawing noar and Lieut. Bullhead asked that pe offor up a prayer before $\dot{\operatorname{startin}} \mathrm{f}$ out and without waiting or calling upon anyone olse, led us in prayer. After this order was issued to sadde up our horses. Hen everyone was ready we took our pladen by two and at the commena "hopo" we etarted.

We had to go through rough places and the roeds ere alippery. As we want through the Grand River bottans as seence as it the owle were hotting at us and tho coyotes were homling all around ua that one of the police remarked that the owls and the coyotes merv giving us marning - "ao beware" he maid.

Betore we startod, Dulihead sasignod Fed Bear and Fhite Bud to have the favorite white hoyse of sitting Bull ${ }^{\prime \prime}$, (mioh was always kept in the tiod or in tho porral at $\left.n i g^{g} t s\right)$ caught and madded up and be in readiness for the Onlef to ride to the Agonoy upon his axreat. The rest of the force were cxtexed to etation themselvee
