Likewise, we are opposed to all persons who are exploiting this old man, Red Tomahawk, and we ask you to disregard any and all pet schemes they may present to you affecting Indians.

The enclosed clipping states that Red Tomahawk smoked the pipe of peace with Marshal Foch and later presented a war-bonnet to Queen Marie and also one to General Summerall. It should be noted that these acts were not promoted by the Indians but were instigated and carried out by white men using Indians for affect. This is true also of his picture being used to mark all the Highways in North Dakota.

If the assassin of Lincoln had been feasted and lionized because of that cowardly act, the American people would understand somewhat how we Indians feel about the entertaining and banqueting of the assassin of Sitting Bull.
