Dear Sir:-

I have your letter of August 14, 1929, with which you inclosed a list of the records which you desire to examine, if on file, in the War Department.

There are on file in my office Post Returns of Fort Yates to 1890, Post Returns of Fort Randall to 1883; Returns of the Division of the Missouri; Returns of the Department of the Platte; of the Departments of the Dakota and Missouri; Reports of Division Commanders and Reports of the Secretary of War.

References are found to Ben Clark in connection with Indian Affairs, but nothing is found of record concerning the expedition of Sitting Bull's Camp in Canada in the Summer of 1878.

It is probable that the archives on file in my office contain material relating to Sitting Bull's surrender in 1881, his release from confinement in 1883, and the steps taken with a view to his arrest in 1890.

Should you decide to visit Washington I would be pleased to afford you every facility for examining these records, if you will call at my office in the War Department. It is suggested that you bring this letter with you.
