

enforced by the Agent, Gall repairs to the agency and insists on having the matter fully explained, after which it is never questioned by him or his people, of which he has about 500 in his individual band.

On all occasions he advises his people to adopt the white man's ways and says that the Indians need never resist the Government. During the present "Messiah craze", Gall has given his influence for peace, and it is largely to this great influence that the trouble has been as small as it has at Standing Rock Agency.

Sitting Bull was a false prophet, and so far as the American people are concerned, he sailed through this world under false notoriety.

Gall was always at the head of each fight, but seldom found in dirty massacre work. He conducted the Custer fight and should have had the honors of same, but circumstances gave it to Bull. Being a man of courage, nerve, ability and commanding tact, he was foremost among the Indians in their fight for liberty. Now that they are overpowered, and must change to civilization, this great power among them has been changed for good, and his future life will be, as the past nine years have been, of importance to the American people in connection with the settlement of the Indian question.
