

Take the Tetons separate, the Huncpapa in their territory and the Oglalas in their territory. SB was the head chief among the Huncpapas and Red Cloud among the Oglalas.

I heard the Indians talk about some of the valuable belongings of SB such as his chief's clothes. At the time when he was arrested he asked that his wives give him his best clothes. It seems that his chiefs shirt and other clothes were given him all except the war bonnet. He was killed in this shirt and nobody knows what became of that shirt.

There were some few left behind, including a blind woman with a half paralyzed grandson. This was Brave Thunder's mother-in-law. The boy was the son of Brave Thunder. These were left behind after the arrest of SB and the police found them after the others had fled.

SB must have weighed about 175-200 pounds.

I saw SB about the time they were camping around the agency during the summer of 1889 when they were having so much excitement over signing the treaty. They were in the camp. In the council he was sitting there. This council was in the camp, not at the agency. SB wore a chief's shirt of buckskin, beaded costume including leggings and mocassins. He painted his face vermillion. This is a paint they use a good deal and a paint that SB used sometimes without any other color. The paint would be put all over his face. This bright color is worn for special occasions. In cold weather and on special occasions he uses a darker shade of red. They have some grease which they take and mix with the paint. The paint was partly a protection against the sun. At this time SB did not have a bonnet. His hair was nicely combed, fur-trimmed braids. He was in his full costume then. All other times I saw SB he was dressed in everyday clothes.

Only the chiefs and camp criers made speeches on horseback.

The whips that were employed in society dances are more for use while the dance is going on. Outside of that I never heard of their being used. They might start up a song and be wasting time and music if nobody sings so somebody has to remind
