Most of these were Tetons and friendlies. They were not necessarily important men.

Coups - Never could be given to anyone except in certain cases. For instance if there was a song started at a dance intended to the wounded warriors who were present someone would get up and dance in his father's honor. His father may be wounded. They would recognize that one as dancing in his father's place if his father were dead. No one had a right to dance in a man's place if that man was living. According to the information I gathered from the old timers it seems that they cannot give enough of SB's war party adventures. At first I thought there were too many pictures. The old people, Gray Eagle and One Bull, felt the same way but when you go into details it seems that most of those pictures were true. He could not receive any honors that belong to somebody else.

Fled and Abandoned Him in a Tepee (by his Mother) - This is not the true interpretation of that name. That is a disgrace and this name is not known among the Sioux. There is name similar to this but it does not have the meaning expressed. The translation of that is Runs Away Without Him or He was Left Behind when the others ran away from the enemy. Among the SB band of Indians that is a very popular name. It is very probably referring to the time when Four Horns was left behind.

"A Fish" is a name given to anyone who has peculiar ways. Sometimes the most insulting name given to an Indian man is that he is a woman. That is another way of saying that he is cowardly.

SB surrendered with the understanding that he would go back to his people at Standing Rock and they took him to Ft. Randall instead.

Polygamy - I don't think Bishop Martie objected so much as the agent. But they thrashed it out and found out it was a custom already established and that they couldn't change it. A great many of them died still living with their several wives.
