

At last, the sixteenth of October, ~~we~~ we started back, carrying on our carts 1,776 cows killed by 55 hunters. This meat formed 228 taureaux, 1,213 bales of dried meat, 166 boskoyas or sacks of

fat, each of them weighing 200 pounds, and 556 bladders of the marrow, of 12 pounds each; the entire amount, estimating at the lowest rate, being worth a little more than 1,700 pounds sterling. The expenses of the trip and the wages of the employees amounting only to about 200 pounds sterling, there remains a 1,500 pounds sterling, earned by 55 hunters in the space of less than two months, counting from the day of departure to the day of return.

We numbered an all 309 souls; I had catechised regularly 68 children; mass was said every day;
