Silent Eaters, Amila wota, Cante tuiza (Brave Hearts) Night Brave Hearts, Tokala Fox, Iroka bad gut Sotka yuha Lance order (Hinhan sapa) Owl feather Miwatani Madan) Hinpopapa These were soldiers Wiimska these were dancing order.

Who were the Silent Eaters?

One of the orders "Cangi yuha" carry the Crow. hanksaska -- order of Tall Men.

In what year did Sitting Bull make his home on Grand River, after he came back from Fort Randall? Who built his two houses?

His own band -- Little soldier and his brother in 1884.

The Silent eaters were of the council lodge where all the chiefs represented their band. This was done so there would be order when at council there was no joking nor laughlig no narratting of funny stories. No women, children or dogs were ever allowed. There A man did the cooking and served each man carried his own dished and took care of it. There were generally
