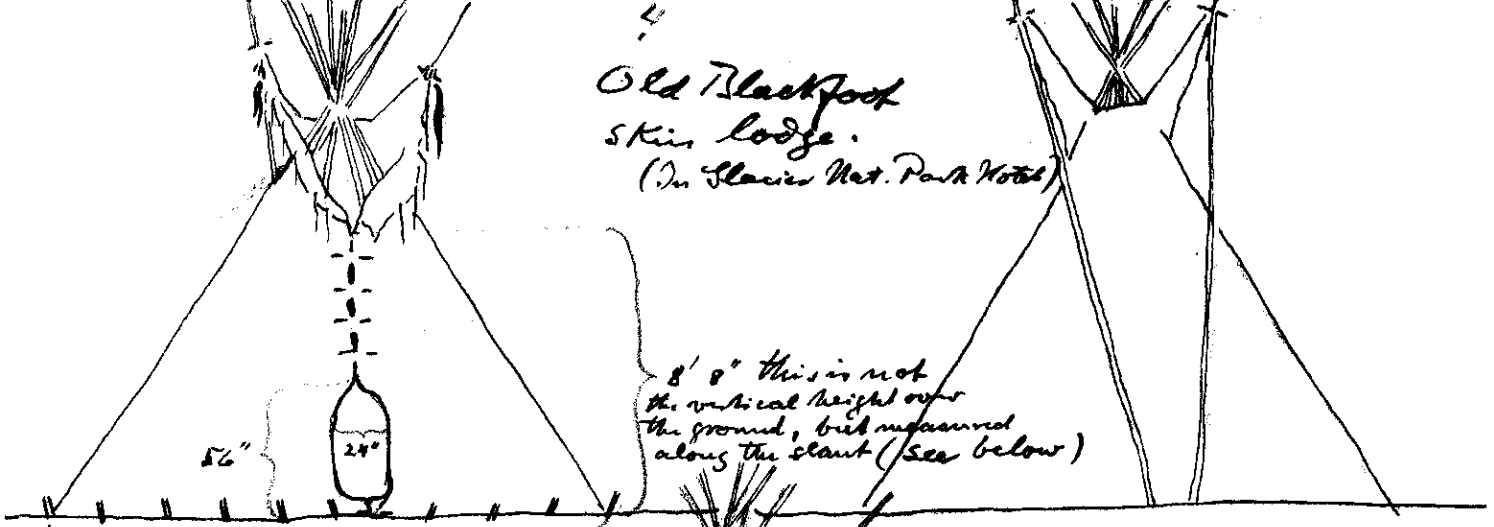
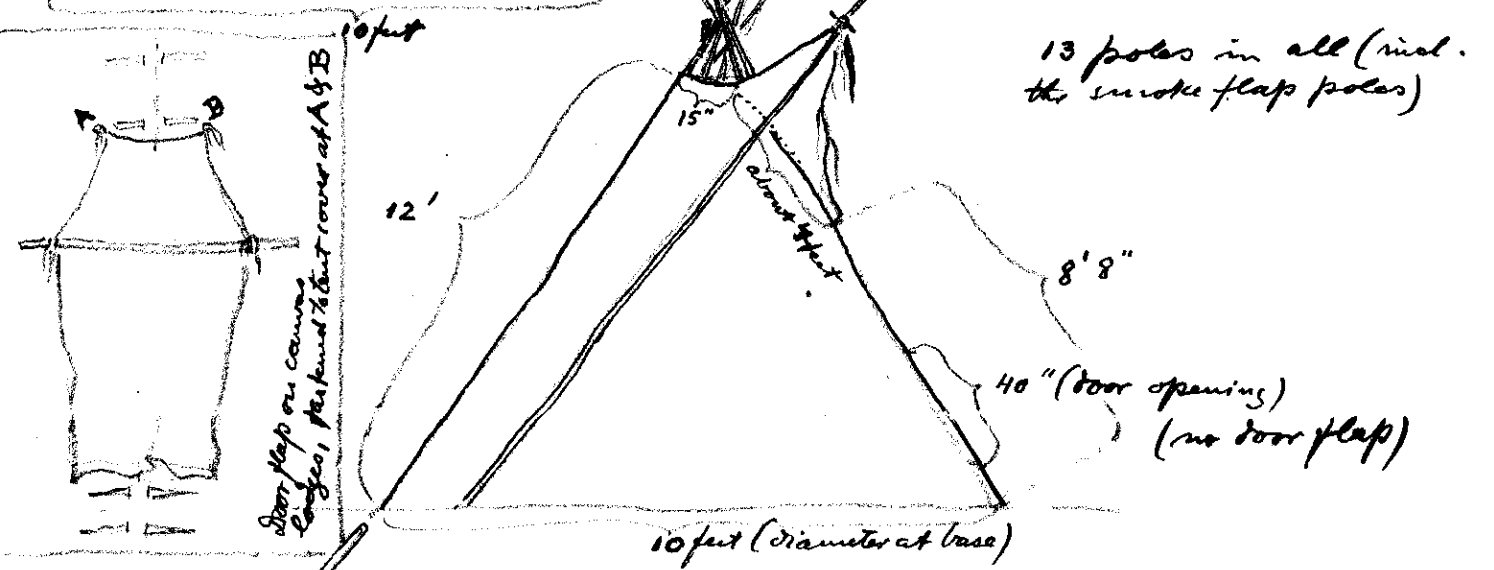

 (In Glacier Nat. Park Hotel)



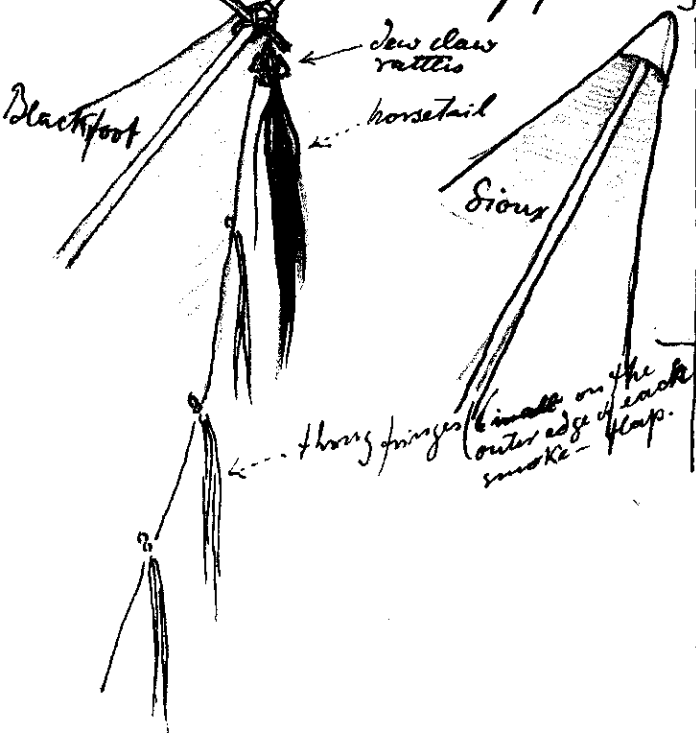
8' 8" this is not
