

P.S. It may be advisable for you to state when you submit your manuscript to prospective publishers, that you plan - unless the publisher for some reason advises another course - to have the book illustrated principally by marginal pen drawings, head and tail-pieces at beginning & end of chapters in the same medium.

Whether there should be any full-page illustrations in wash drawings or colored illustrations, perhaps a frontispiece in color, should be left to the opinion of the publisher, since it is principally a question of expense.

If you want me to illustrate the book, it would be necessary that you state this fact explicitly when you send the ms. to the publisher. You may also state that I have illustrated a European <sup>(German)</sup> edition of Dr. Eastman's Ind. Boyhood (copies of which I can send to any address you mention - including yourself) & also Eastman's "Old Indian Days" which will soon appear.

As soon as your Ms. is accepted & the publisher agrees to let me illustrate it, please let me know some of the most striking incidents you wish illustrated so that I may have as much time as possible to do the work because I will lose several weeks in late summer and fall through our removal.
