Dear Professor: -

Many thanks for the additional photos and your letter of 7.7.20. I shall try to correct the drawing of the lodges as suggested.

The "photo of an eagle group from the Field Museum" I did not find in the package of July 1<sup>st</sup>. Did you forget to put it in?

The recent calumets had no bowls attached but the Sioux told me that it was formerly the case. They always represent the calumet on their lodges with the bowl. There is one calumet with a catlinite bowl in the Museum in Stuttgart which was brought to Europe by Prince Maximilian, probably the only one in existence today. It also has the four woodpecker heads (of the *picus imperialis*, the ivory bill, now almost extinct).
