

But since Henry seems to have seen the calumet without the bowl the custom to leave it off seems to go back to at least that time. I shall therefore leave them off in my picture of the dance, but in a tailpiece (decorative) at the end of Chapter 4 I shall represent the calumets complete with the bowls as I have frequently seen them pictured on the lodges of the Ogala.

As to the color of the lodge-coverings in my frontispiece, I shall assume old ones with a brownish color so as to contrast favorably with the blue of the decorative border (beaded blaumat strip).

Since you are very accomodating in making concessions or changes in the text to suit the illustrator, which certainly will help to improve the illustrations, I would ask to strike out the word "spotted" before "pony" on p. 3 of Chap. V. - By the way you
