A spotted pony would give me considerable trouble in the illustration at least in one of them (see the enclosed sketches) because the spots interfere very much with a distinct modelling of the anatomical details of a horse, especially so in black & white work.

The enclosed sketch for the head of Chap. I is not final. The size of the boy will have to be reduced to bring that figure into proper relation to that of the Mandan. Also the figure of the Mandan will have to be redrawn. The arrangement (grouping) & details of equipment will, however, remain just about as the sketch shows, unless you should ask for changes. (Observe the shield, for instance with the buffalo head & dragon fly design)

The tracings show hardly more than the outlines, but enough, I hope, for you to recognize the essential de-
