1) I know of no formula for changing a man's name. The one given in Eastman's "Indian Boyhood" in about the 2nd or 3^d Chapter (changing Hlakade's name to Ohigese) is hardly authentic (probably Mrs. Eastman's invention).

2) In the chapter heading for Chap. II "Windwind's lodge (the large one) is at the eastern (right hand) end of the horseshoe (camping circle). The side of your tracing showing the lead pencil marks is the right side & shows the drawing as it will appear in the book.
