Dear Sir:-

In answer to your letter of the 29th ultimo, I beg to advise you that I have taken the matter of Chief Sitting Bull's visit to this locality up with the Sioux Indians and am informed that he never came this far East and none of the Sioux here ever saw him. There is only one old man left at the Village and he came to Canada as a very small boy. I trust this information is what you require. I regret the delay in answering your letter. I have only recently returned from paying Treaty.
