

Dakotas (in 1745-6-?) list to Del. assignee
at Big Stone Lake 19 of their young men received with
cards for killing 3 Frenchmen in Illinois - Del set
them free

about 1760(?) Dakotas move to Mo. River

NB - during the Revolution the Sioux under Wapashaw

(see ~~Neil~~ Niell - Hist of Minn. (Ed. Duffield) (4th ed?)

p. 227 -

was loyal to English from whom he had obtained

Medals (in 176? -) for Sioux tribes on trip to
Quebec to offer self as sacrifice for trader killed
year before by Ixatope, in order to restore trade to his
people (Robinson - p 56-7)

to protect their trade in West, but took no
part in war vs Colonists - After treaty

Eq still held Dakota country + it was 40

yrs before they acknowledged U.S. authority -

even in 1796 & Fr had posts in S.D. (about 1800)
coming up from St. Louis
