The ye'nis or wild rose is much esteemed amon, the prairie tribes for its red seed berries, which are pounded into a paste and dried for food. It is frequently mentioned in the phost songs, and is sometimes pictured on the ghost shirts. Although rather insipid, the berries possess nutritive mulities. They are gathered in winter, and are sometimes eaten raw, but fore generally are first boiled and strained to get rid of the seeds. This dough-like substance is sometimes mixed with marrow from broken bones and pasted around sticks and thus roasted before the fire. It is never tacked away for future use.
