(C) ~~Lawyer~~ planned with his brother to found
an ethnological & natural history museum.
Brother drowned in a whirlpool near Seneca Falls
> lawyer about that time

> 1823 > a painter, sold low bhury -
"convertng of int paint jobs" went to

Philadelphia - 5 years there

> portrait & miniature painter
made a reputation that "admitted him

to the fellowship of Thomas Dully, Charles
Wilson and Rembrandt Peale." & won
him the place of Pennsylvania Academician
in the Academy of Fine Arts, & portrait

Painter of General Winfield Scott
Dolly Madison and Governor

De Witt Clinton (who d. in 1828).

(He painted the Erie Canal

in Roman costume for the opening of the Canal
& displayed in the Seneca Chief (boat) | 1825
For this he got a medal & election to NY Natl Academy / over
