Copy of Letter from Grayeagle, & Gabriel, to McLaughlin on his departure as Agent to become an inspector. It expresses deep regret at his departure and appreciation for all that McL. has done for the Indians. Asks if McLaughlin cannot even yet decide to stay on as their agent. Says as Chief of the Hunkpapa band of Sioux Indians at this agency he expresses the sentiment of 215 families, 789 persons.
