I understand that he was called Blanket Chief, but I am not clear which tribe gave him that name. I should very much like to know what the Cheyenne words for

(1) Blanket *Ni stōme*

(2) Chief *Vi hōn nīve*

(3) Blanket Chief *Vi hō nīve āh home*

might be. Also, I would like to know whether the terms given below are Cheyenne words and if so what they mean.
