I am returning your letter of September 12 with as much information as I could get. You will notice that the answer to Question No. 1, the Arapaho for blanket is "hoe", for chief it is "naya" and blanket chief it is "na-ya-no". In your second group of questions our interpreter says that the first word should be "nasapy" would be niece in English. He says the other words are not Arapaho.

I hope that this information will be of value to you.
