I am enclosing my check for \$5.00 and hope that for this sum you will be able to supply some information on the points listed below. I am prepared to send a further payment of \$2.50 when I receive your reply. A while back I wrote you about the matter and as yet have had no reply.

I would like to ask for the Crow Indian words, spelled out in English, for the following terms:

- buffalo robe Bee-shay mee-shay or Buffalo blanket.
- (2) blanket mee-shay
- (3) chief ma-Chaa'-chay
- (4) Blanket Chief meish-ba-chaa! Chay
- white man mar-ee-stae-shee-lay or wellow a-wa-kaari-way mountain sheep or big horn chay
- (6)
- the young or lamb of the mountain sheep or any female (7)

I would also like to have you translate some words which I found in an old book and which the author claimed were Crow words if you can interpret these:

(a name for cheyennes)

(1) Shiam Shospusia - ee-sar-eesh-poo-shay! or His arrow feathers are

(2) Masta Sheela _ white man or yellow eyes.

(3) Umentucher (5)

Umentuchen Tukutsey Undewatsey - Do not Expose what love I have for you.

Casapy - ca-sak-pay. (In a laughing manner)
