

Battle of the Rosebud

June 17, 1876

The defeat of General George "Three Stars" Crook by the hostile Sioux and Cheyennes. Redrawn from the map made by Cyrus Townsend Brady for his Indian Fights and Fighters from a sketch by General Anson Mills by permission of Doubleday and Company.

Black dots indicate hostile Indians.

Small circles indicate Government Indian scouts.

- A = Mills' Battalion.
- B = Noyes' Battalion.
- C = Henry's Battalion.
- D = Van Vliet's Battalion
- E = Chambers' Mounted Infantry and Pack Train.
- aaa = Mills' line of march down the Rosebud River and back again.
- bbb = The route of the hostiles circling Crook's command as they rode back to their camps on Reno Creek.
