Dates of Some Principal Events of Punitive Expedition.

1916

- March 9—Columbus raid; 17 Americans killed.
Prompt action by Tompkins, killing many on Mexican soil.
- March 15—Thirteenth Cavalry crosses at Columbus.
- March 16—Seventh and Tenth Cavalry cross at Culberson's Ranch.
- March 17—Seventh and Tenth Cavalry arrive Colonia Dublan, (108 miles)
- March 19—Tenth Cavalry (rail and marching) and Seventh Cavalry move on San Miguel.
- March 29—Dodd attacks at Guerrero, killing 80 or more Villistas.
- April 1—Tenth Cavalry attacks Beltran at Aguas Calientes.
- April 12—Tompkins attacked by 300 Villistas at Parral. American loss, 2 killed, 6 wounded,
1 missing. Mexican loss, 42.
- April 21—Dodd attacks Temosachic, inflicting numerous casualties.
- May 5—Howze attacks at Ojo Azules, killing 61 Villistas.
