William J. Karty, a full blood Comanche Indian of pleasant, friendly personality, has achieved many honors given by the Plains Indians in their councils. He has also been active in civic work in Anadarko, where he maintains his residence. He has been the CCC-ID educational and welfare director for the past five years.

Karty holds the honor of being the youngest chairman of the Inter-Tribal Council of Kiowa, Comanche and Apache Indians. He is the youngest chairman of the Comanche Tribal Council. He recruited the Comanche Indian Signal Corps for the United States army, which is now an invaluable aid to the war effort. He is the youngest president of the American Indian Exposition and has held this office for the past three years.
